GREENFIELDS PRE-SCHOOL ~ SPACES AVAILABLE



We have a few spaces becoming available in our Pre-School and places are free for those 2 year olds who are eligible.

At Greenfields, the 15 hours pre-school provision is taken as either 5 morning or 5 afternoons:

→ 5 mornings from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

or → 5 afternoons from 12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.

(The cost for 5 morning or 5 afternoon sessions is currently £73.05).

NO DOGS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS



Please remember that dogs are **NOT** allowed on the school site.

One of the reasons for this rule is to minimise the risk of children getting a round worm infection called toxocariasis from dog faeces.

There are two types of toxocariasis: one type can cause inflammation of the liver, with symptoms such as severe stomach pain. The other type can cause significant visual impairment or even blindness.

Please help us to keep the children as safe as possible by respecting the No Dogs on Site rule.
