### 30 HOURS CHILDCARE

Letters have gone out this week offering eligible children 15 hours nursery provision in addition to the 15 hours universal provision currently available. Space limitations mean that we are only able to offer this 30 hour provision to children who will be starting their reception year in 2018/19.




The Government have confirmed that families who want the 30 hour entitlement in the Autumn 2017 term should register at the earliest opportunity and must have completed their 30 hour registration on the Childcare Choices website <https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/> **before September 2017. Families who register in September 2017 will not be able to access their entitlement until January 2018.**

Entitlement codes should be brought into school to confirm places offered before the end of term and families need to reconfirm their eligibility for the 30 hours every 3 months, or they will enter their grace period to go back to 15 hours.

Instead of buying from the school office, uniform will now be for sale online from Emblematic at:

<http://studentuniform.co.uk/gcps151>.

You will also be able to buy directly from the Emblematic shop in Longbenton, once the shop refurbishment works are completed.

This means that you will be able to buy uniform throughout the school holidays, weekends and evenings. Buying directly from the supplier in this way will also make it cheaper and any uniform ordered online can be delivered free to the school for you to collect from us, or delivered to your home address for an additional postage fee paid to the supplier.

We do still have some uniform in school that we will be selling at a reduced price to clear the stock we have. While these stocks last, you will be able to buy sweatshirts from the school office for £8.00 and cardigans for £8.50.
