CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

**Where would be the best location
for a cycle café?**



As **AUTHORS** we will:

- Design a persuasive advert to encourage tourists to visit Warkworth
- Write a tourist information letter
- Carry out a detailed project to be presented to the cycle café owner

As **READERS** we will:

- Read texts relating to journeys and map work e.g. Shackleton's Journey by William Grill.

As **SPEAKERS** we will:

- Debate which location is most suitable for a cycle café

As **MATHMETICIANS** we will:

- Plan and calculate the cost of a trip to Warkworth
- Data handling - surveys and graphs
- Use compass points to describe movement and direction

As **GEOGRAPHERS** we will:

- Define what a settlement is
- Explain what makes a location a good place to live
- Recognise different types of settlement
- Discover why people settled in particular places - looking at key features that are attractive to settlers
- Compare and contrast locations using our map skills
- Use aerial photographs to look in detail at Warkworth and Wideopen
- To understand land usage, including the types of buildings and layout, in Wideopen and Warkworth
- Learn to use ordnance survey maps and understand the map symbols used
- Make a map of Warkworth using the symbols we have learned
- Understand how to use 4 point and 6 point grid references to describe location

As **COMPUTER SCIENTISTS** we will:

- Use google maps street view to look in detail at locations
- Research how locations have changed

As **CITIZENS** we will:

- Go on a trip to Warkworth and empathise with the residents regarding changes to their local area
- Understand advantages and disadvantages of these changes

As **HISTORIANS** we will:

- Look at how Wideopen and Warkworth have changed over time using old maps and aerial photographs
- Discover the past and present uses of the Waggonways and Weetslade Pit Heap

As **ARTISTS** we will:

- Make sketches of Warkworth castle and the view along the river bank whilst on the trip

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
