

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

What type of art makes a sound?



As HISTORIANS we will:

- Find out about the 1960s, fashion, sport, music, toys, space
- Look at biographies of musicians and artists
- Order events chronologically on a timeline
- Look at inventions over a period of time
- Discover how people lived during the 1960s.

As READERS we will:

- Read different texts about the 1960s and art in the sixties
- Look at evidence and read information which tells us about how people lived during the time
- Read, listen and interpret song lyrics

As MUSICIANS we will:

- Listen and sing to a variety of music from the sixties
- Write our own song lyrics and music
- Find out about famous musicians and the inspiration behind their music

As ARTISTS and DESIGNERS we will:

- Explore pop art from the 1960s
- Examine the work of different artists
- Create our own pop art using different techniques
- Explore the technique of collage, creating our own
- Collect materials to use in our art work
- Plan and organise our ideas
- Evaluate our work
- Replicate and design album covers

As MATHEMATICIANS we will:

- Order numbers on a timeline
- Round money
- Add and subtract
- Solve word problems

As SCIENTISTS we will:

- Identify appliances that run on mains and/or battery electricity
- Create a poster to warn people about the dangers of electricity
- Learn about protons, neutrons and electrons
- Make circuits
- Investigate conductors and insulators

As AUTHORS we will:

- Write conversations between the characters in Pop Art
- Explore the use of vocabulary and language
- Write biographies of famous 60's artists
- Write interview questions for a famous musician

As CITIZENS we will:

- Look at the importance of the 1960s for our society today
- Look at special people in the Christian faith
- Look at the rights of people in the 60's
