<p>As READERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Read and explore the book 'Highway Robbery' by Kate Thompson. ▪ Use non-fiction books such as the Guinness Book of Records. ▪ Look at reports in the media. 	<p>As MATHEMATICIANS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Look at place value, addition and subtraction, geometry and measures. ▪ Order numbers to make a timeline. ▪ Collect data in a tally chart and make bar graphs. 	<p>As ACTORS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Take on different roles in our work. ▪ Hot seat. ▪ Use drama and freeze frames. ▪ Explore conscious alley.
