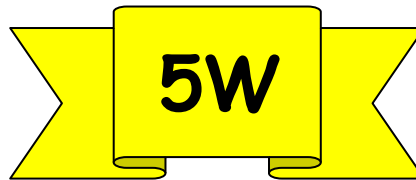

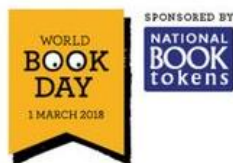
The closing date is **Friday 23rd February** and there will be prizes for the most extreme / inventive places. The winners will be announced the following week, on World Book Day.
