## THE HISTORY MYSTERY

Mr Lumsdon has set this challenge to all of the children at Greenfields:

On Salisbury Plain in Wiltshire in the south of England, there is a huge man-made circle of standing stones called Stonehenge. It was built by our ancestors over many hundreds of years and is one of the world's most famous prehistoric monuments . . . and one of its biggest mysteries too!



### Stonehenge: How do you think it was built?

This is a question that has baffled people for centuries - and even to this day, no theory has been proven! How could people thousands of years ago have moved and arranged such huge stones?

A legend from the 12<sup>th</sup> century claims that giants placed the stones on a mountain in Ireland, then a wizard called Merlin magically moved the stone circle to England.

Mr Lumsdon would like the children to have a go at explaining how Stonehenge was made. Children can present their answer in any way they want to: written explanations, pictures, diagrams, or even video clips and there will be prizes for the best ideas.
