<p>As READERS and WRITERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We will learn the story of Dougal's deep sea diary, developing stamina for writing. ● Write diary entries in the first person. ● Write for a range of purposes including year 1 features. ● Develop our own confidence with reading comprehension. 	<p>As MATHEMATICIANS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Spend time investigating measures. ● Practise and consolidate the four calculations (+, -, x, ÷) ● Begin to develop an understanding of reasoning and problem solving. 	<p>As GEOGRAPHERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Find where they live on a map of the UK ● Identify the 4 countries making the United Kingdom and name their capital cities ● Answer questions about the weather
<p>As HISTORIANS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recount interesting facts from a historical event or the life of someone famous from Britain in the past and think of reasons why things happened that way ● Compare how things in their life are different to when their parents and their grandparents were their age ● Answer questions by using a specific source such as a non fiction book or asking an older person 	<p>As MUSICIANS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Use their voice to speak, sing and chant ▪ Copy sounds and repeat short rhythmic patterns ▪ Say how a piece of music makes them feel and whether they like or dislike a piece of music with reasons ▪ Choose sounds to represent different things 	<p>As SCIENTISTS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Learn about plants and living things. ● Dissect plants, labelling different parts and finding out about their purpose. ● Undertake an experiment to find out what plants need to grow.
	<p>As ARTISTS and DESIGNERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use simple IT mark-making tools (e.g. brush and pen tools) ● Learn the primary colours and what secondary colours they make when mixed. 	<p>As CITIZENS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Know and respect that people are different. ● Understand we control our own behaviour. ● Become ready for change and new beginnings through transition work to year 2.
