

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Wish you were here? FRANCE



As READERS we will:

- Read a story that is set in France and complete related activities
- Read fiction and non fiction texts to find information about life in France
- Recount events (e.g. the Christmas Truce)

As AUTHORS we will:

- In role, write letters to loved ones from the frontline
- Write our own story set in these times.
- Write an eye witness account of the Christmas Truce

As COMPUTER TECHNICIANS we will:

- Use search engines effectively
- Research using websites
- Use tools (e.g. copy and paste) to present research.
- Combine font, graphics and images to create a propaganda poster

As HISTORIANS we will find out about:

- The reasons for the outbreak of war
- The notable personalities involved
- How the government encouraged men to enlist through propaganda
- How the soldiers travelled to France
- Life and warfare in the trenches
- Real life letters sent from the frontline and use this evidence to find out more about living conditions
- Use photographs and documents to find out more about life as a soldier
- The Christmas Day Truce

As ARTISTS and DESIGNERS we will:

- Evaluate parcel boxes and test them
- Create a design for a parcel box that will travel to the Front
- Look at ways to make them stronger and more durable
- Evaluate our work and discuss our ideas

As GEOGRAPHERS we will:

- Find the counties on a map that were part of the Triple Entente and the Triple Alliance
- Find Flanders on a map and look at weather conditions
- Locate areas in France and explore the human and physical features

As SCIENTISTS we will:

- Explore different ways we can keep healthy
- Think about different food groups and the impact each one has on keeping our bodies healthy

As CITIZENS we will:

- Discuss how we can get along with everyone
- Think about the differences between us
- Find positives about ourselves and identify the positive things we are good at rather than the negative
