If you are thinking about having your child's ears pierced, we would ask that this happens at the start of the Summer holidays, so that by the time term starts in September, they are able to remove their earrings.



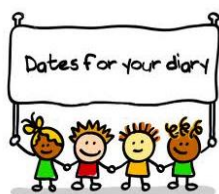
We understand that certain items of jewellery have religious significance. If parents/carers contact school requesting that their child be permitted to wear specific jewellery for religious
