Every finalist was presented with a fantastic bag of goodies worth £100.





Whoops Baby Child Lifesaving Course

The Whoops BCLS Course is a great way to get a lot of information over to parents in a very short period of time.

In just one 2 hour session we cover all aspects of home safety and accident prevention, and equip parents with the skills and knowledge to perform emergency first aid, including how to prevent a choke, deal with a full choke if it happens and perform CPR on a baby and small child.
