NUT ALLERGIES REMINDER

For children with severe nut allergies, exposure to nuts may result in anaphylaxis. This is when the airways from the lungs become swollen and make breathing difficult. There can also be a drop in blood pressure and an increase in heart rate, leading to collapse or unconsciousness.

Allergic reactions can be caused by:

- eating anything that contains nuts, or skin contact with anything that contains nuts
- touching someone, who is eating anything that contains nuts, or has done recently
- being in the same room where anything that contains nuts have been

As you know, we want school to be a safe place for all of the children and for this reason, children should **NOT** bring nuts to school, or anything that contains nuts, for either their snack or packed lunch. If your child would like to bring chocolate spread to school, please check that the chocolate spread does not contain nuts.

Next week is Anti-Bullying Week and the theme for 2018 is to choose respect over bullying and to choose to respect each other at school, in their homes, in their communities and online.

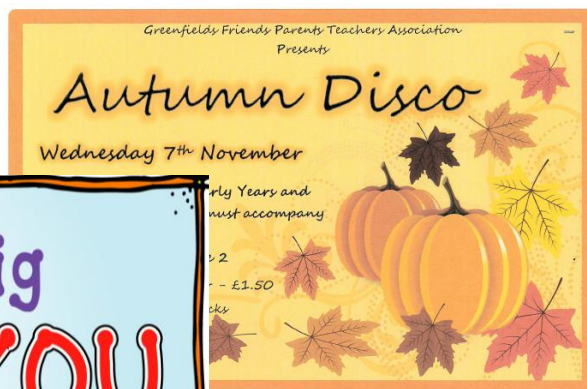


The aims of this week will be to help the children to understand:

- That we all need to choose to respect each other both face to face and online

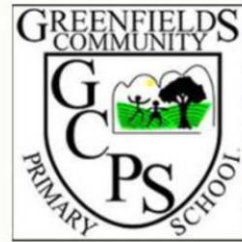
AUTUMN DISCO
