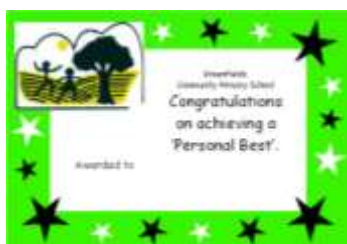

'PEOPLE WHO HELP US' VISIT RECEPTION

FINALLY . . . NATIONAL CHILD MEASUREMENT PROGRAMME

The National Child Measurement Programme is delivered by the local authority's school nursing team and involves measuring the height and weight of all children in Reception and Year 6.

Growing healthily and maintaining a healthy weight is important for children physically, socially and for their mental wellbeing.

Parents of children in Reception and Year 6 will soon be receiving letters to inform them about the programme and what to do if they want to withdraw their child from being measured.

Every year, throughout England, more than a million children in Reception and Year 6 have their height and weight measured at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme
