Sadly, a few children have not been able to collect their uniform merit this week, because they have been wearing clothes that are not school uniform or have come to school wearing earrings.

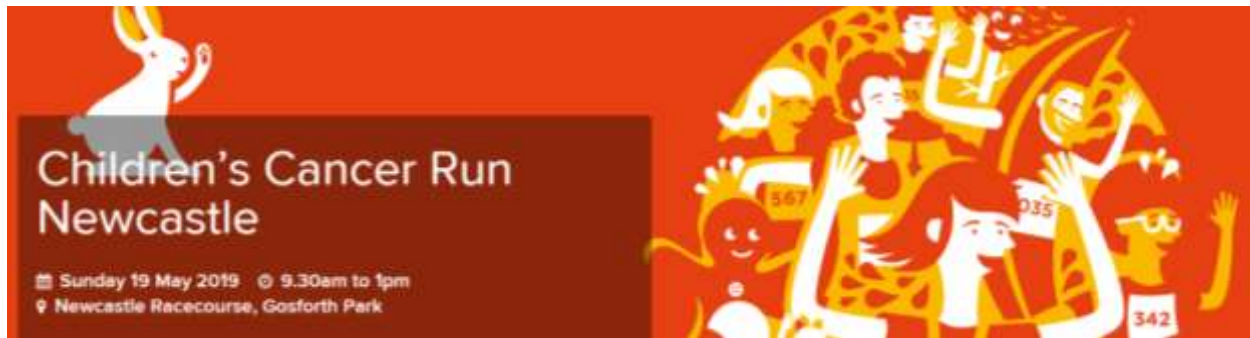
