Know why we have rules in society and come up with some rules for the period if we lived in it.

Think of adjectives that we could use to describe the appearance of people who lived during the Stone Age. 	<p>As ARTISTS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create our own cave drawings and attempt to use some of the methods that hunter-gatherers would have used. Research Iron Age/Celtic art and patterns and create our own designs.

Read and research about the different types of homes and discuss similarities and differences to now. Look and infer from cave drawings and create some of our own. 	<p>As AUTHORS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In role, write a diary entry of what it is like to live in the Stone Age. Create a recipe for the diet of someone living in the period (based on what would be available) Create a visitor guide for Skara Brae. 	<p>As GEOGRAPHERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look at how settlements changed from early hunter gatherers to the introduction of farming. Explore how the introduction of farming began to create communities. Use the case study of Skara Brae to explore what early communities looked like.
