
CATERING SERVICES FUNDAY

Catering Services would like to invite pupils in Reception up to Year 6 to their 'Under the Sea' themed funday lunch in school on Thursday 16th January.

Lunch will be served in party boxes and includes a special menu of golden fish bites, served with sauté potatoes and mini corn on the cob with a selection of salads from the salad bar, plus a chocolate brownie and a fruit squash drink. (As usual, all medical diets will be catered for.)

Plus - children can win a prize if they find a golden ticket in their party box.

The meal will be free for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, if you have registered for free school meals. It will cost £2.25 for pupils in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6, if they are not eligible for free school meals.



Your child could have free school meals if you receive any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Pension Credit Guarantee
- Child Tax Credit without Working Tax Credit & an annual taxable income below £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit and an annual taxable income below £16,190
