WORLD BOOK DAY 2020








Everyone looked fabulous in their costumes yesterday and received their World Book Day book token.

If they take their book token to a local bookseller, they can swap it for one of the 12 new and **completely free** World Book Day books.


Or, if they'd prefer, they can use their book token to get **£1 off** a full price book instead.
