Week beginning Monday 1st June

Your new maths activities can be done as a whole family or on your own; it's up to you.

You will be investigating whether a statement is always, sometimes or never true. You will need to record notes on how you are going to investigate the statement, record the things you need to find out, collect the data—this could be as a bar chart, line graph, pictogram and so on — and finally record your findings. All of this can be done on the A3 sheets provided.

Monday	Always, sometimes, never true People who are related to each other have the same colour eyes.
Tuesday	Always, sometimes, never true All members of the same family have the same favourite animal.
Wednesday	Always, sometimes, never true When shapes are cut in half they have the same size parts.
Thursday	Always, sometimes, never true Everyone can write their name backwards.
Friday	Always, sometimes, never true All members of the same family can write with both their left hand and their right hand.
