 ...be original...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure that children are safe; providing a supportive environment that nurtures individual and independent thought and original ideas and approaches.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Support school by attending meetings or being available to discuss your child's behaviour or attendance.</li> <li>Support my child in homework and other opportunities for learning at home.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Always try my best.</li> <li>Do my homework and bring it back to school when it is finished.</li> </ul>
 ...be brave...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Instil confidence in our children through them knowing that they are part of the Greenfields school community.</li> <li>Give children the self-esteem to become strong mentally healthy young adults.</li> <li>Make explicit the link between children's rights and their responsibilities.</li> <li>Always allow an opportunity to learn from a mistake.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Send my child in full school uniform and school shoes, without jewellery and earrings or make-up including nail varnish or nail extensions.</li> <li>Support the school's rights and responsibilities including sanctions/disciplinary, anti-bullying and e-safety procedures.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear my school uniform (no make-up or nail extensions and school shoes, leaving all my jewellery at home.</li> <li>Always follow the school rules: ~ Listen carefully and do as you are asked ~ Make good choices</li> <li>Be truthful.</li> </ul>
