be original	 Ensure that children are safe; providing a supportive environment that nurtures individual and independent thought and original ideas and approaches. 	 Support school by attending meetings or being available to discuss your child's behaviour or attendance. Support my child in homework and other opportunities for learning at home. 	 Always try my best. Do my homework and bring it back to school when it is finished.
be brave	 Instil confidence in our children through them knowing that they are part of the Greenfields school community. Give children the self-esteem to become strong mentally healthy young adults. Make explicit the link between children's rights and their responsibilities. Always allow an opportunity to learn from a mistake. 	 Send my child in full school uniform and school shoes, without jewellery and earrings or make-up including nail varnish or nail extensions. Support the school's rights and responsibilities including sanctions/disciplinary, anti-bullying and esafety procedures. 	 Wear my school uniform (no make-up or nail extensions and school shoes, leaving all my jewellery at home. Always follow the school rules: Listen carefully and do as you are asked Make good choices Be truthful.
