<p>In <b>English</b> we are;</p> <p>-Exploring a range of different texts and writing for a range of purposes.</p> <p>This half term we are looking at both 'The Matchbook Diary' and 'The Arrival'. Be courageous in the ambition you have for yourself.</p>	<p>In <b>Maths</b> we are;</p> <p>Starting our spiral curriculum over again. Children will begin on place value where we will look at decimal numbers (tenths, hundredths and thousandths). We will then move onto addition and subtraction, multiplication and then fractions. Children will have the opportunity to explore mathematical concepts through concrete, pictorial and abstract representations.</p>	
<p>In <b>Science</b> we are learning about Earth and Space. We will;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Describe the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the sun in the solar system</li> <li>-Describe the movement of the moon relative to the Earth</li> <li>-Describe the sun, Earth and moon as approximately spherical bodies</li> <li>-Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky</li> </ul>	<p>In <b>History</b> our question for this half term is;</p> <p><b>'Has Africa always had the opportunity to grow and prosper?'</b></p> <p>We will be answering this question through our research on the Kingdom of Benin.</p>	<p>In <b>DT</b> we will be;</p> <p>cooking bread and seasonal soup by following a set of instructions and working with a variety of equipment safely.
