In Maths we are; -Counting in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward -Recognising the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones) -Identifying, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line -Comparing and ordering numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs -Reading and writing numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words -Using place value and number facts to solve problems
In Science we are learning about; Animals including humans. We will: -Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults -Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) -Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene	In History we are learning about; Is it important to remember the consequences of the past? Our work in history will have a local and regional focus, beginning by thinking about our own memories before moving on to look at remembrance and developing our own understanding about consequences of the past. This will include a visit to the war memorial.	In Art we are: Drawing - Tell a Story Using storybook illustrations as a stimulus, children develop their mark-making to explore a wider range of tools and experiment with creating texture to add detail to drawings.
