WIDER SCHOOL RE-OPENING - 1st June 2020

School continues to be closed for the vast majority of children until further notice. You will know from the letter that was sent to all parents and carers earlier in the week that our stepped approach will begin on the 1st June 2020.

Step 1: w/b June 1st 2020

Our school will **only** be open for children who have:

1. an Education Health & Care Plan
2. a Social Worker
3. a parent whose work is critical to the COVID-19 response, as detailed on the government's 'key worker' list **and** has sent through to school evidence from their employer to this effect.

We will set a date to move to step 2, but only when governors feel that it is safe to do so, and we have reviewed how our step 1 plan is working in school. We hope that you will understand that we must do everything we can to make sure that school is a safe place for all of the children and school staff.

School will be closed during half term. The weekly food hampers will be available to collect from the front of the school between 12pm-2pm on Wednesday 27th May.
